Dear FPC Members & Friends,

Recently I came across an engaging article suggesting that simple pauses during important daily activities can improve effectiveness and help achieve important goals.

In his 2009 book "The Checklist Manifesto," surgeon and author Atul Gawande describes how three short pauses during the surgery process reduce harmful medical errors. He calls them "pause points."

Dr. Gawande documents how brief pauses 1) before anesthesia is administered; 2) before the incision is made; and 3) before leaving the operating room can slow the pace of procedures and result in better outcomes. Each pause point takes no more than sixty seconds. During the pauses, the surgery team uses lists to make crucial checks, such as verifying the patient's identity before beginning the procedure and, before ending the surgery, confirming that all the needles and sponges are accounted for.

Gawande's research reported significant results for the eight hospitals that tested his "pause points" during surgery procedures. The rate of major complications for patients decreased by 36 percent and deaths fell by 47 percent. As a result, it is now common for many hospitals to include "pause points" for surgical procedures and patient care.

In our individual lives, and in our teamwork as the Church On The Square, FPC members have many opportunities every day to use "pause points." Pause points can slow down the tempo of our daily activities, allow us to reflect on what we have done so far, and invite the Triune God to provide a "light for our feet and a lamp for our path" for the rest of the day. (Psalm 119:105)

When we take sixty seconds to offer a brief prayer, a moment to think about a familiar Bible passage, or remember the verse of a favorite hymn, we invite the Holy Spirit to help us do our best to love, serve, and worship in Christ's name each day.
