WE ARE ALSO PROVIDING HOMETOWN GROCERY GIFT CERTIFICATES AS WE HAVE FOR THE PAST SEVERAL YEARS INSTEAD OF THE TRADITIONAL CHRISTMAS FOOD BASKETS. WHILE THE CHURCH HAS BUDGETED SOME FUNDS FOR THE BASKETS AND EXPENSES, WE WILL NEED ADDITIONAL FUNDS BECAUSE OF THE INCREASED FOOD PRICES. AS USUAL WE WILL COLLECT ADDITIONAL DONATIONS TO FULLY COVER ADEQUATE BASKETS, PURCHASE ANY NEEDED ADDITIONAL PRESENTS, AND TO HELP FAMILIES WITH OTHER NEEDS SUCH AS UTILITY OR RENT ASSISTANCE OR POSSIBLY OTHER BILLS.
