The Apostles themselves, who set on foot the conversion of the Roman Empire, the great [leaders] who built up the Middle Ages, the English Evangelicals who abolished the Slave Trade, all left their mark on Earth, precisely because their minds were occupied with Heaven.

It is since Christians have largely ceased to think of the other world that they have become so ineffective in this. Aim at Heaven and you will get earth "thrown in": aim at earth and you will get neither. ... Most people, if they had really learned to look into their own hearts, would know that they do want, and want acutely, something that cannot be had in this world."

I look forward to worship, fellowship, learning, and servanthood that God calls us to as we help build God's kingdom as the Church On The Square during 2025.
