One of the highlights for me of First Presbyterians Sunday Worship Service is the place in the Order of Worship when we say what we believe in the words of the Apostles Creed. This is one of those times when the unity of our confession of faith shines Christ's light in the middle of a world filled with conflict, confusion, and distress.

As I stand in front of the congregation and look out at the First Presbyterian Church Family, I feel blessed and encouraged as you confess your faith using words that have been spoken for over two thousand years. This is a moment of crystal clarity that reminds us that our ultimate loyalty is to the Triune God who created us, saves us, and daily holds us in the palm of his hands.

As we say the Apostles Creed in worship, we focus on what we agree on, the most important things that join us together. Differences like personality, income, education, politics, age, ethnic origin, and faith experience all find their place in the kingdom of God under the gracious care of the Risen Christ.

Every time we say these ancient words, they come alive in our family of faith today. As we finish the creed, we experience the unity that we confess:

"... I believe in the holy catholic church ("worldwide"); the communion of saints ("unity and fellowship of all who open their heart to Jesus"); the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and the life everlasting. Amen"

Our unity in Christ is a sign of hope, help, and blessing for each other, for the Athens community, and for the world that God loves.
